




Alcohol-Related Fatal and Personal Injury Crashes Percentage of Alcohol-Impaired Drivers Who Are Female




Alcohol-Related Fatal and Personal Injury Crashes Alcohol-Impaired Drivers by Age Group

Nearly half of alcohol-related fatal and personal injury crashes occur on the weekend.

Note: Fatalities refer to people, while crashes refer to the crash event. One fatal crash (the event) may involve more than one vehicle and more than one fatality. All data were obtained from the NYS Department of Motor Vehicles; includes police-reported crashes only.
