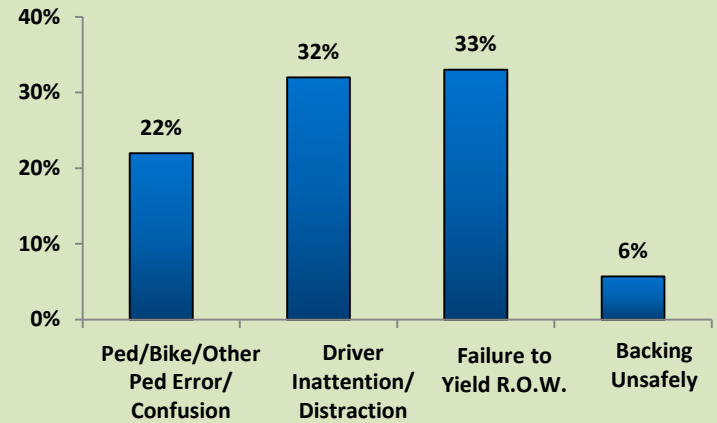


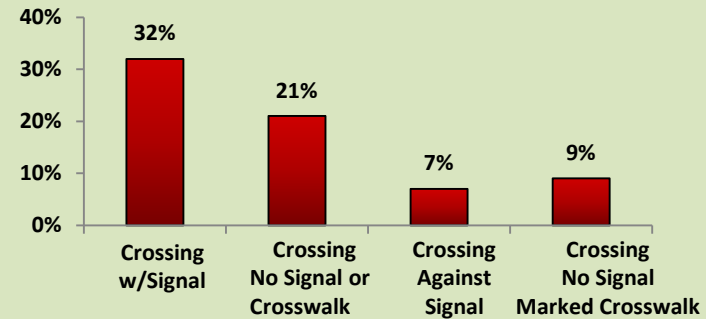

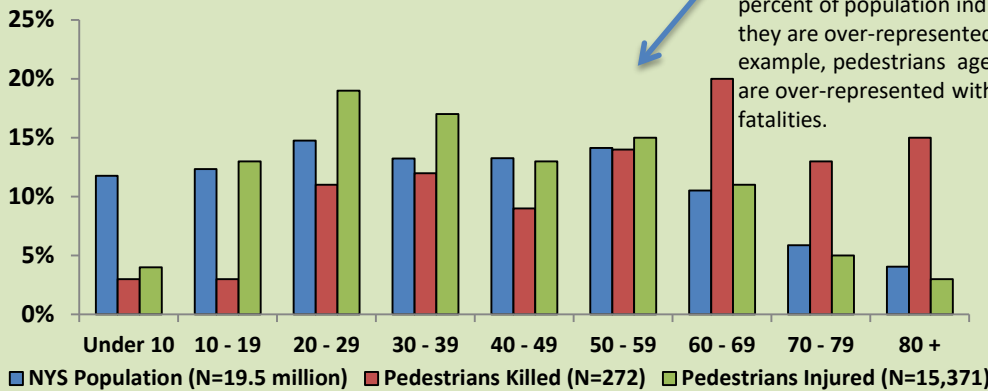
## Pedestrian Fatal and Personal Injury Crashes\* Select Contributing Human Factors 2018



## Pedestrian Action in F&PI Crashes\* 2018

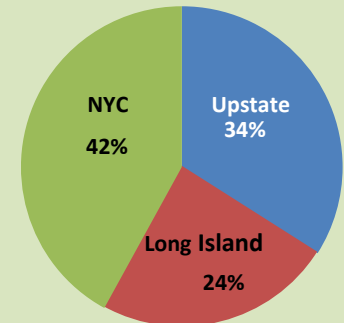


## Pedestrians Killed and Injured by Age: 2018



In interpreting these data, any age group with a greater percentage of pedestrians killed or injured than the percent of population indicates that they are over-represented. For example, pedestrians ages 50 and over are over-represented with respect to fatalities.
