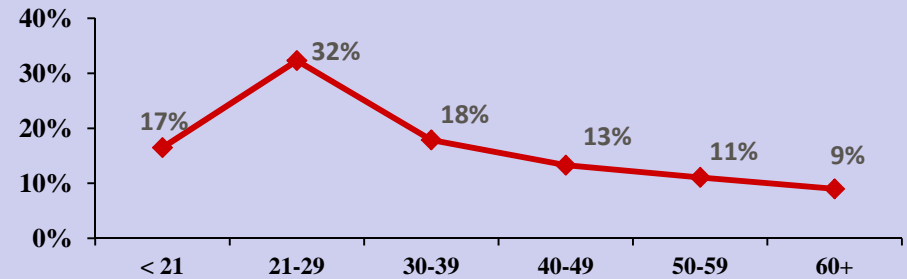

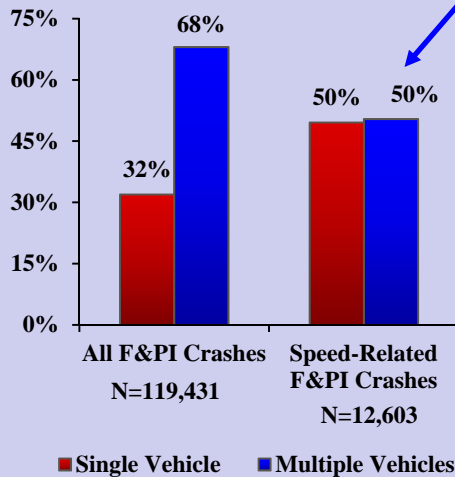
Speeding Drivers in F&PI Crashes by Age: 2014



Other Top Contributing Factors Associated with Speeding Drivers in F&PI Crashes: 2014

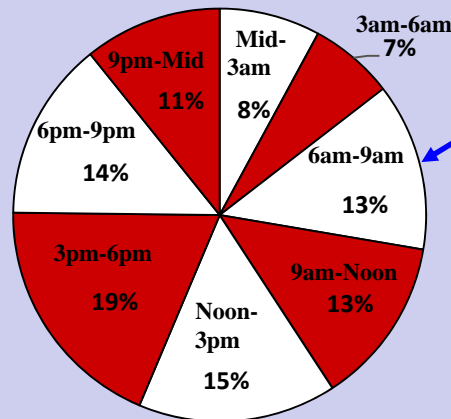

Slippery Pavement	13%	24%

Failure To Keep Right	5%	3%
Following Too Closely	2%	11%

Speed-Related F&PI Crashes by Manner of Collision: 2014



Speed-related F&PI crashes are much more likely to involve a single vehicle than all F&PI crashes (50% vs. 32%).

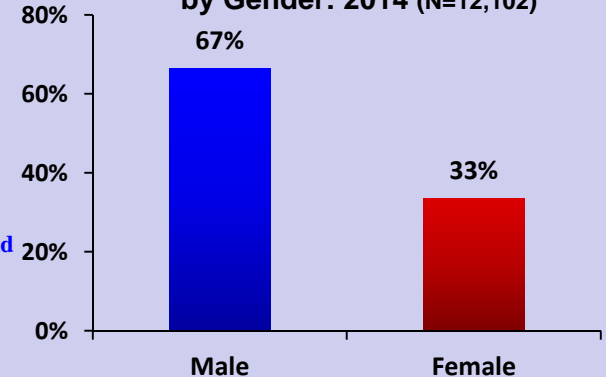
Speed-Related F&PI Crashes by Time of Day: 2014 (N=12,587)



One-third (34%) of speed-related F&PI crashes occur between noon and 6pm.

Speeding drivers in fatal and personal injury crashes are twice as likely to be male.
