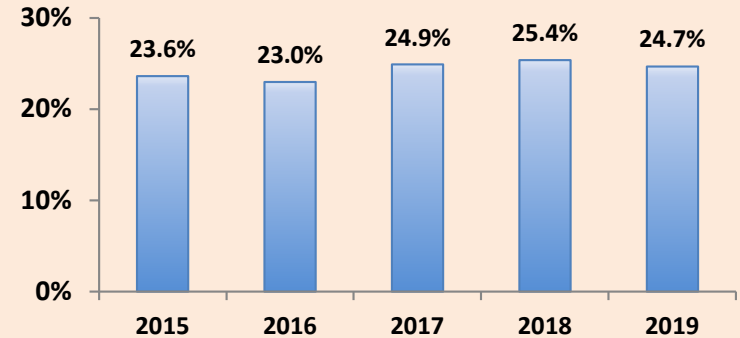

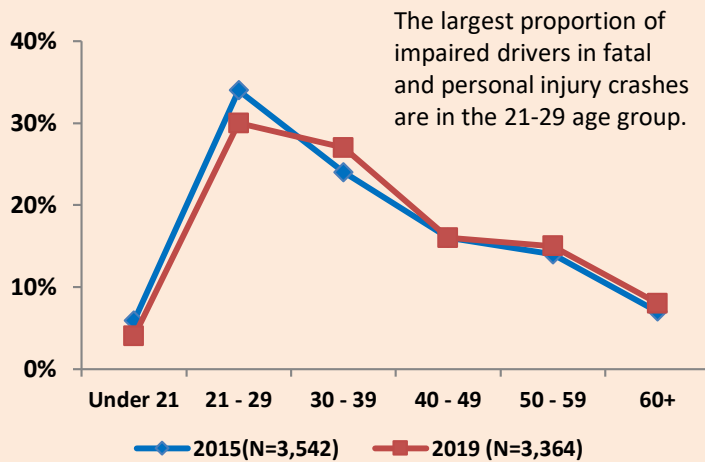

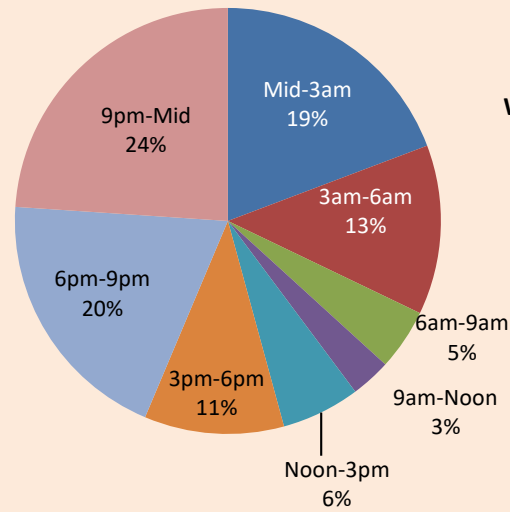
Alcohol-Related Fatal and Personal Injury Crashes Percentage of Alcohol-Impaired Drivers Who Are Female



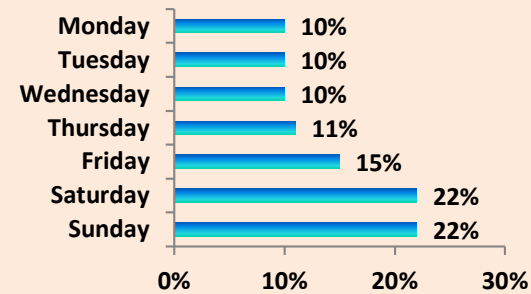
Alcohol-Related Fatal and Personal Injury Crashes Alcohol-Impaired Drivers by Age Group

More than 4 out of 10 (44%) alcohol-related fatal and personal injury crashes occur on the weekend.

Note: Fatalities refer to people, while fatal crashes refer to the crash event. One fatal crash (the event) may involve more than one vehicle and more than one fatality.

*Alcohol-Related Crashes are identified based on the presence of a contributing factor for alcohol involvement or a citation for driving while impaired by alcohol or a positive BAC. Includes police-reported crashes only.
