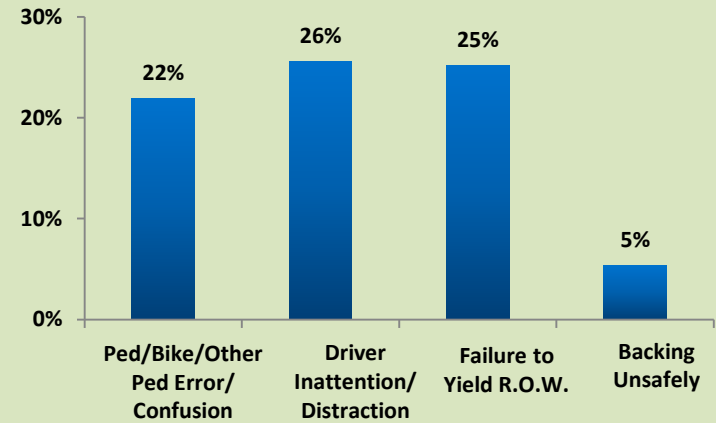


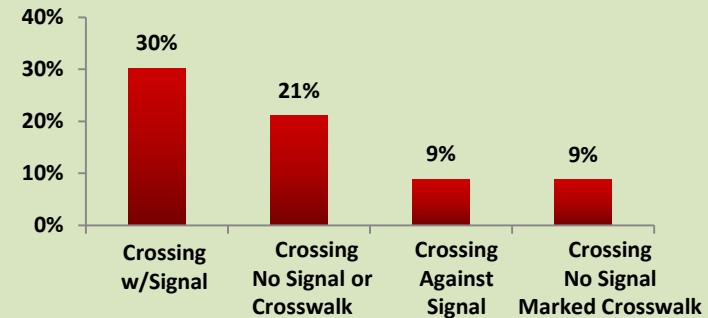

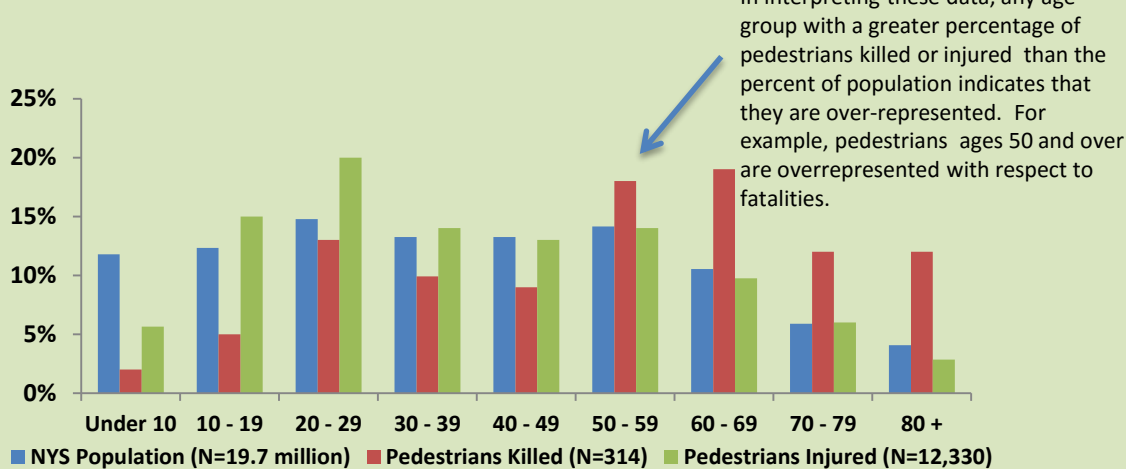
Pedestrian Fatal and Personal Injury Crashes* Select Contributing Human Factors 2015 (N=12,679)



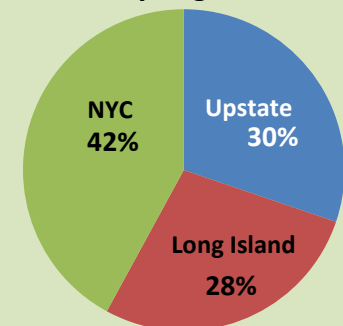
Pedestrian Action in F&PI Crashes* 2015 (N=13,292)
