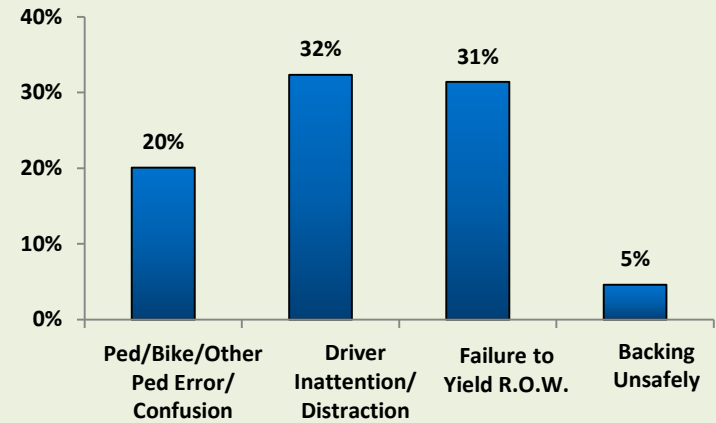


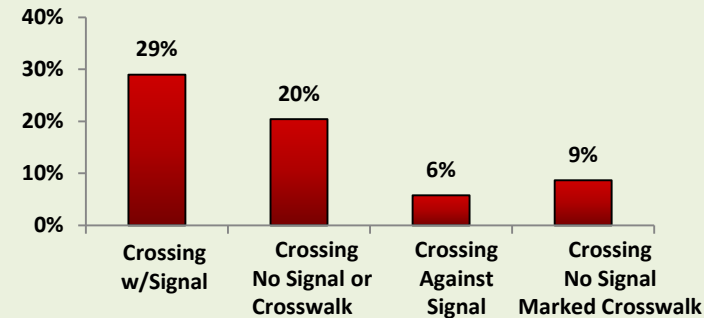

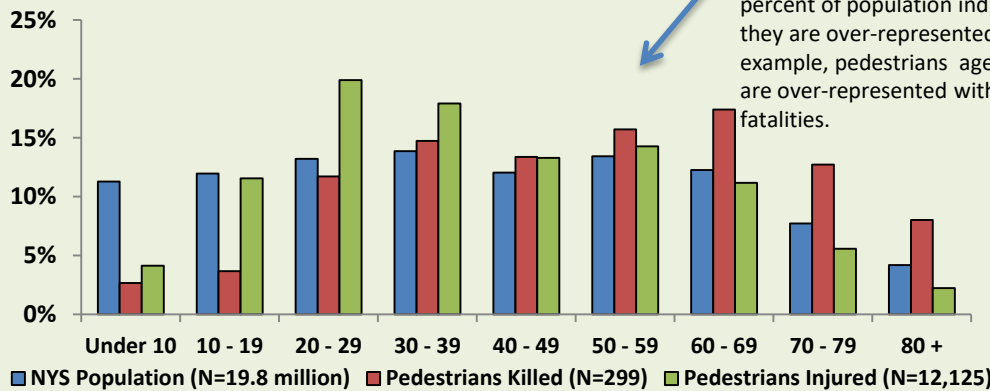
Pedestrian Fatal and Personal Injury Crashes\*

2021

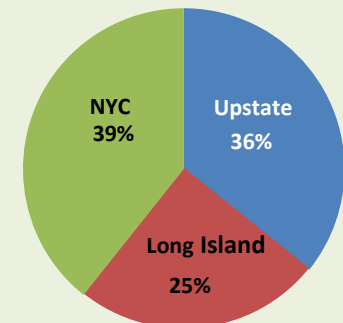


Pedestrians Killed and Injured by Age: 2021



In interpreting these data, any age group with a greater percentage of pedestrians killed or injured than the percent of population indicates that they are over-represented. For example, pedestrians ages 30 and over are over-represented with respect to fatalities.
