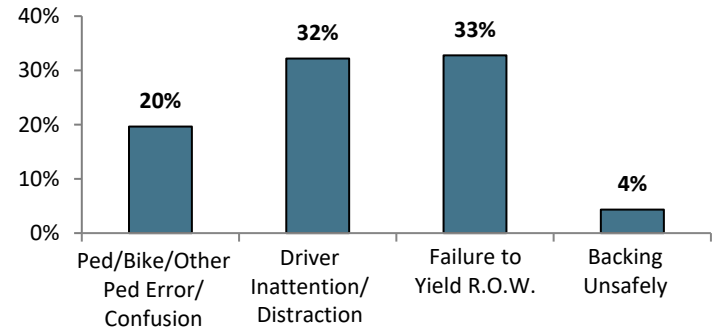


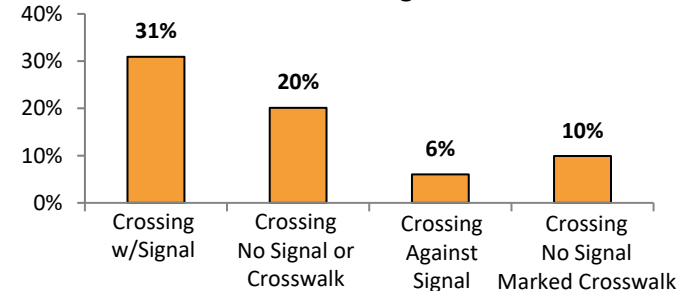

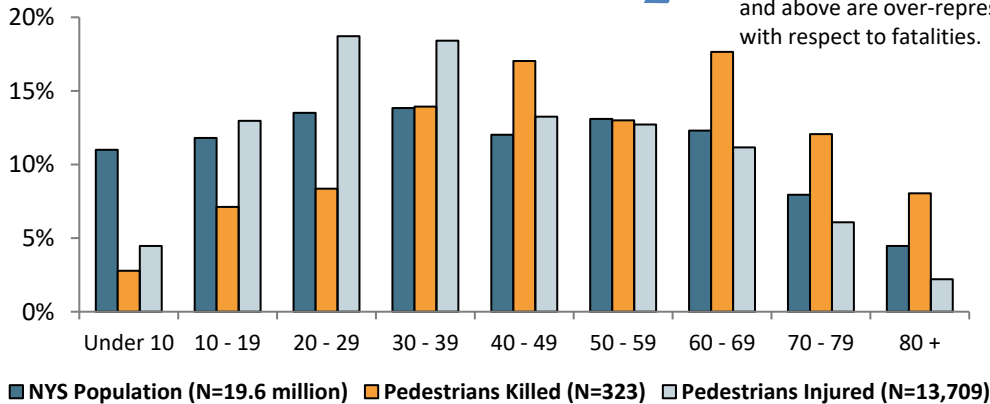
**Pedestrian Fatal and Personal Injury Crashes*

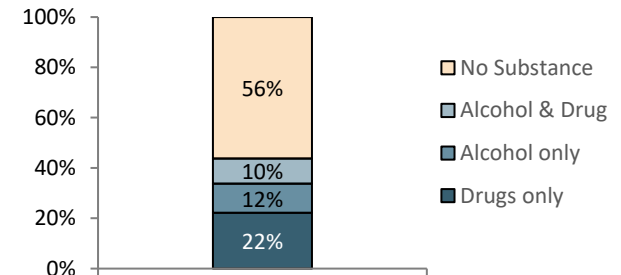
